He spoke about the first stakeholder meetings held in Taos on January 14, 2025 and Colfax on January 15, 2025. We will be having monthly meetings going forward until they go live. 	wanted to put that out there if anyone is interested in applying. I will let Jamie Goldberg take over and give more background to this. Jamie Goldberg- Gives a little background of the crime reduction grant act. In the past we have not accepted juvenile applications. We are now accepting those applications. Right now we are asking for 3 million from the legislature, but are not sure on the full amount yet. We would like to get these grants approved as early as possible. This will be the first time that we are opening up these grants to be used for juveniles! Opening these grants for juveniles and getting grants in on time are 2 things that we need to work on. We will have the CJCC convening in April if anyone is interested in attending. We pay for the hotel, dinner and breakfast. We plan to end the convening around 3:30 so people that are traveling can make it home in good time. Thanks everyone for their time.
