We would like to hire an outreach worker to meet the individuals when released to help connect them to services outlined in COR. The main goal for the project is data collection to further identify the needs and barriers to meeting conditions of release. Working in collaboration with HCAP. Trying to connect with pretrial services but have had scheduling issues.</p> <p>Krossroads has multiple clinics throughout the state. They are currently tracking CORs. Inclusive to their practice. Engage clients in the courtroom. The biggest gap appears to be communication services. Feels the gap when someone is released.</p> <p>RGATP has been utilizing Treat First to help bridge that gap. This allows 4 visits before assessments.</p> <p>DA feels the gaps have been identified. McKinley County has identified areas/hubs where they can go to attend court due to transportation and connectivity. Possibly identifying hubs in Penasco and Questa.</p> <p>b. The main focus is trying to recruit survivors for the focus groups. Numbers are pretty low. If someone is interested they will be screened.</p>
