4. Behavioral Health Reform and Investment Act (BHRIA)- Esperanza Lucero (AOC)

Hannah Smith- BHRIA Statewide Program Manager Esperanza Lucero is not on today, but we will try to get her on the next Joint CJCC meeting.

Hannah Smith gives an update:SIM mapping has taken place in our district but we will need to hold another SIM mapping workshop. Dates aren't announced yet, but should be scheduled soon. The BHRIA Program has announced mini grants for a lead county in each Behavioral Health Region to fund coordination work. The SIM Map used by the BHRIA program has been revised to include a pre-intercept for individuals who are not or won't ever be in the criminal justice system and to include the juvenile justice system.

Valerie- believes that they are having a webinar around this and is asked if anyone is going to attend and report out. Hannah believes it will only be open to county leadership to attend. They really want this to be held by the counties in the district.

Dr. Conder- Asks if anyone has spoken to the Colfax County Commission. Hannah does not believe so but is unsure. Dr. Condor suggests contacting Si Trujillo who is on the City Commission to share Esperanza Lucero's contact info.

5. CJCC Membership- Hannah Smith	New Hope Family Counseling would like to become a non voting member of the Colfax/Union CJCC. JPO motions, Youth Heartline seconds. Their services include a community closet, hygiene product distribution, and a diaper program. Diapers are distributed on every third Wednesday of the month.
