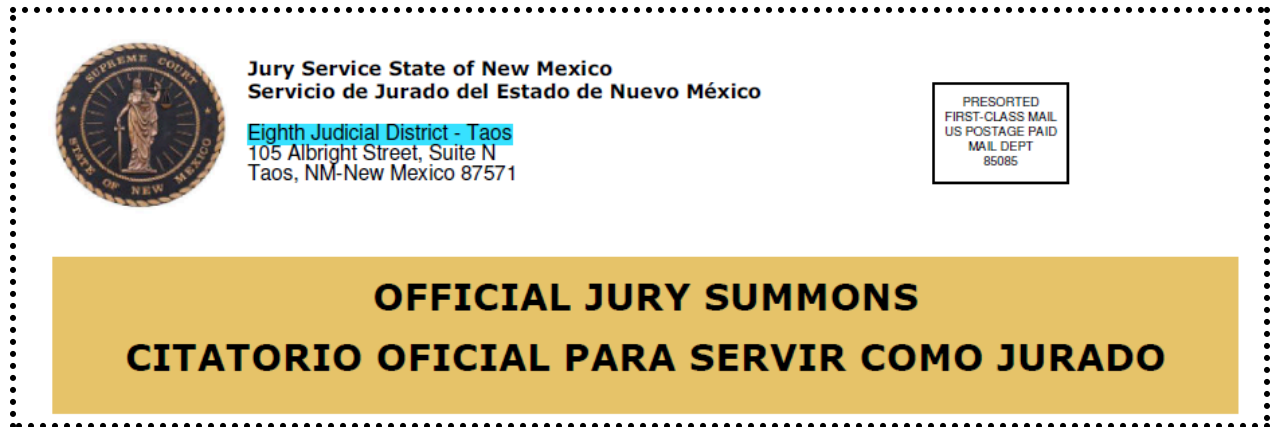
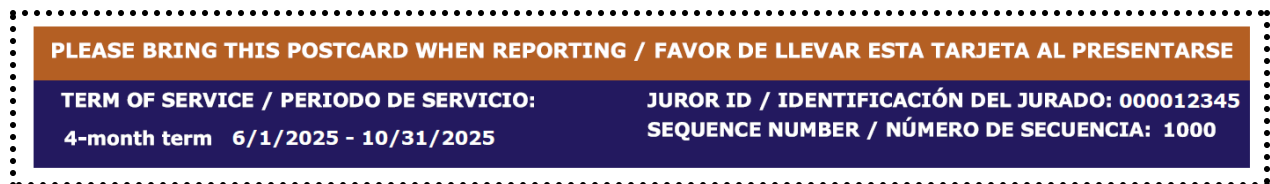


General Jury Service Information

Not sure if you are a District or Magistrate Court Juror, or what your pool group or sequence number is? All of this information is located on your summons. The Court that has summoned you appears on the return address on the front of your summons:



And your Term of Service, Pool Group, Juror ID Number, and Sequence Number are on the back:



What is a Pool Group? Pool Groups are based on the Term of Service listed on your Summons.

Taos County Court's Pool Groups are currently as follows:

District Pool	Term of Service	May 4 through July 31, 2026
District Grand Jury	Term of Service	March 2 through May 29, 2026
Magistrate Pool	Term of Service	March 1 through May 31, 2026

I have plans and will not be available on certain days. What should I do?

We understand that you may have conflict dates during your term of service, and we strive to accommodate all jurors. Please provide written notice of any preplanned vacation, work-related travel, or medical appointments during your term of service.

Please include your name and Juror ID to expedite your request. Please be advised that requests made less than five days in advance may not be accommodated. (See Contact information below.)

How long does jury selection take?

Jury Selection can take on average 2- 3 hours, but it may take longer depending on the type of case. Therefore, please prepare in advance and plan accordingly.

How long does the jury trial last?

Some trials are finished within a day, others may take several days. The Judge will tell the jurors during selection how long the trial is anticipated to last.

Please note: Depending on the type of case, District Court Jury Selection may be either IN-PERSON or REMOTE using Google Meets. Please pay close attention to reporting instructions.

If jury selection is remote, Jurors will be provided a Google Meet link to join the meeting. You must have a camera and internet access to appear for remote jury selection. Do not come in person unless you **cannot** appear by video.
